*A book club for adults who enjoy reading and talking about children's books*

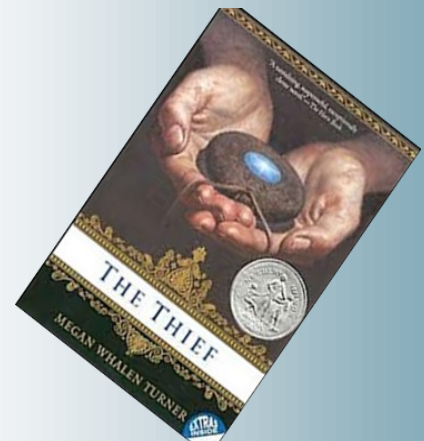
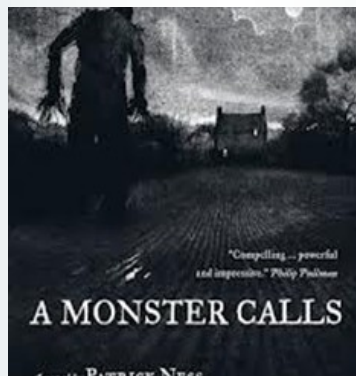
**First meeting: 5.30 pm, Tuesday, 26 February, 2013, at Black Cat Bookshop, Padding-**
