Drawing on its own collection and knowledgeable volunteer staff, NCACL also consulted teachers, teacher librarians, librarians, literacy and literature experts, academics, staff at the ACT Education Directorate and future users and experts who piloted and tested the database.

- Uses an intuitive, user-friendly design for searching by author, illustrator, title, series, publisher, publication date, Australian Curriculum, Early Years Learning Framework, audience level, key concept and annotation.
- Offers a diverse range of genres and artistic styles.
- Includes annotations that allow searchers to grasp the essence, context and synopsis for each book.
- Gives teachers, librarians, parents, caregivers, home schooling groups and others working with young people information about quality resources.
